We want you to have a great but safe time on our 400+ beaches and coves, which include Blue Flag, Seaside Award, Recognised Bathing water beaches and most importantly RNLI lifeguarded beaches.

- Between two Red & Yellow flags**
Safe to swim and belly board.
- Between two Black & White flags**
No swimming. Area used by surfers and kite/windsurfers.
- Red Flag**
No swimming at all.

Cornwall welcomes dogs all year round. With over 150 dog friendly beaches and attractions, it's the perfect holiday destination for you and your dog.

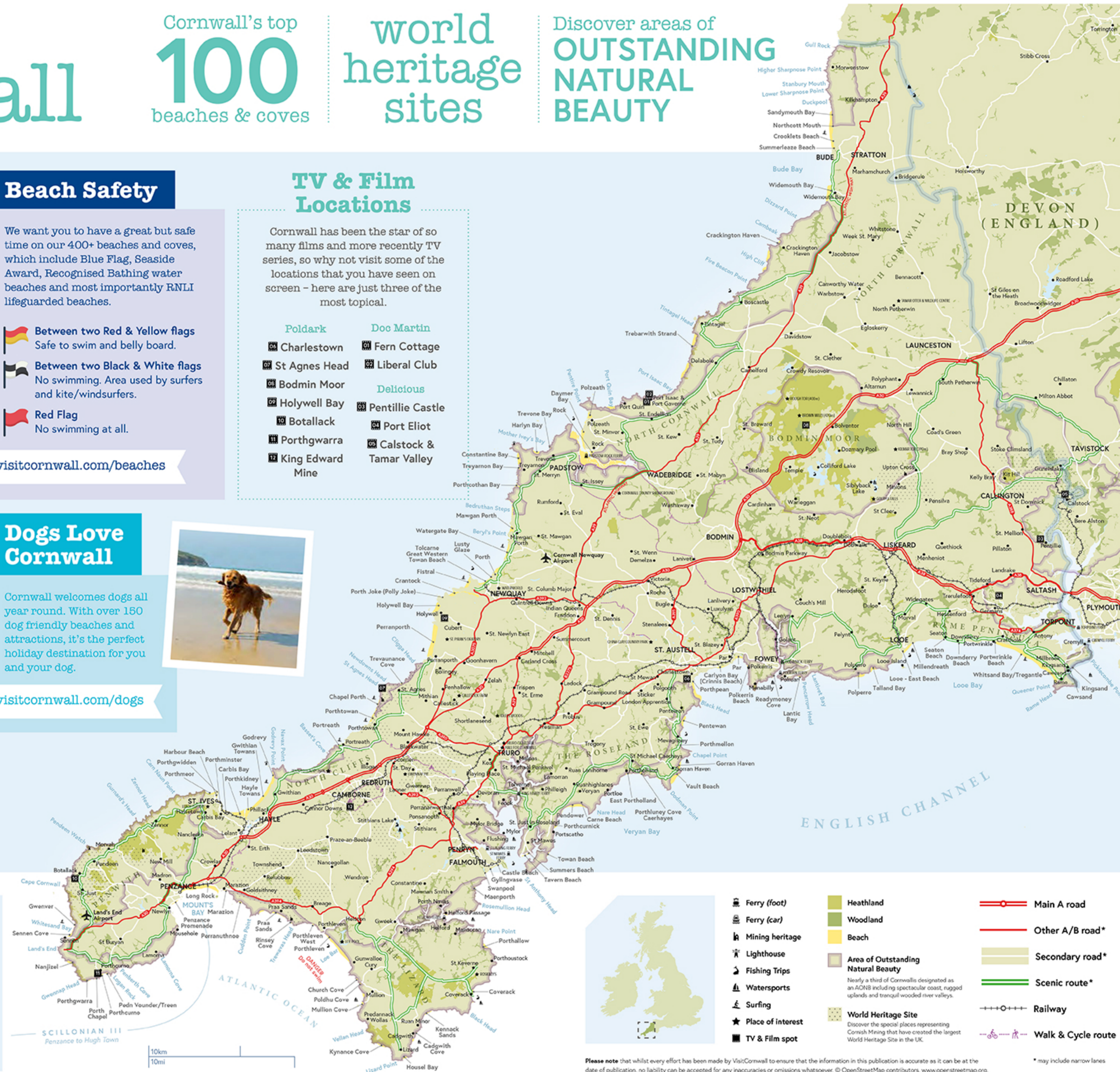
