TV's dramatization of Winston Grahams novels took in many of Cornwall's rich and stunning sites from Bodmin, Falmouth, Porthcothan but the stand out location had to be on our doorstep – at the St Just section of the Cornish Mining World Heritage Site – in particular Botallack.
