The hotel will furnish families with buckets, spades and fishing nets for a day spent at the beach.

Luxury Family Hotels acknowledge that families come in all different shapes and sizes, and for many, dogs are very much part of the fold. Every dog is greeted with a woof welcome pack and can also enjoy dishes from their 'a la bark' menu and Waggy Tails Tea Time, complete with puppacino.
