Brought to you by Cornwall Council project 'Experience Newquay' in collaboration with its local project partners, the first wave of commissions to be announced as part of the programme are below. With more acts will be announced over the coming months (full programme published by mid Sep):

- **Enchanting Illuminations:** Step into a world of wonder at Trenance Heritage Cottages and Garden Cafe, where themed light displays celebrating the changing seasons will captivate your senses. Keep an eye out for our special displays during Halloween, Christmas, and St Piran's Week.
- **Moonlit Performances:** Experience the magic of dance and theatre under the super full moon! 'To the Moon and Back' by Rob Manner combines dance, theatre, sound installation, and projection to create immersive experiences. Explore transformed spaces in the town centre, co-created with residents, that bring Newquay's community stories to life.
- **Monolithic Marvels:** Witness the creation of three ceramic monoliths by Robin Sullivan and ALMA. Contribute directly to these artworks during summer workshops and delve deeper into Newquay's archaeological heritage.
- **Street Art Adventures:** Unleash your creativity with Slapdash Studio and renowned artists Kleiner Shames, Elle Koziupa, and 45 RPM. Watch as three large-scale murals, each highlighting Newquay's heritage and identity, come to life throughout the town. Plus, discover your artistic side in one of our street art workshops.
- **Family Fun:** From pottery and belly-board painting to sauna experiences and literary talks, our packed schedule of family-friendly events and workshops offers something for everyone.
